EMERGENCY OVERVIEW

PRIMARY ROUTES OF ENTRY

Eyes: Dust may irritate the eyes from mechanical abrasion, causing watering and redness.

Skin: Dust may cause irritation of the skin from friction but cannot be absorbed through intact skin.

Ingestion: Although unlikely under normal conditions of use, ingestion of the dust from this product may result in irritation to the mouth and gastrointestinal tract.

Inhalation: Dust may cause irritation of the nose, throat, and airways, resulting in coughing and sneezing. Certain susceptible individuals may experience wheezing (spasms of the bronchial airways) as a result of dust inhalation during sanding or sawing operations.

Section 5: First-Aid Measures

PRIMARY ROUTES OF ENTRY

Eyes: Remove contact lenses if necessary. Flush eyes with running water or a saline eye solution for at least 3 minutes. If redness persists or visual changes occur, seek medical attention.

Skin: Wash with mild soap and water. Contact a physician if irritation persists or later develops.

Ingestion: If swallowed, dilute by drinking large amounts of water. Seek medical attention.

Inhalation: Immediately leave the area and find a space with fresh air. If shortness of breath or wheezing develops, seek medical attention.

Advice to Physician: Treat symptomatically.
